  - Catch Up Maths for pupils in years four, five and six
  - Literacy Launcher for pupils in year three
  - Ipad Literacy for boys in year six
  - Language and Play for families in Nursery
  - Number and Play for families in Nursery
  - Reading workshop in Reception
  - Music performance for pupils in years one, two, three, four, five and six
